TOWARD INCORPORATION,

The Board of Directors, after many delays, has drafted and approved for recommendation to the entire Association, a set of Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. This would enable the Association to become a non-profit corporation, and, under recent interpretations, become not only tax-exempt (whatever money we raised would not be taxed), but possible tax-deductible (whatever money we got could be deducted by the donor as a gift). The next stage is to have these documents presented to the entire Association. That will be done at a general meeting to be held on Tuesday, November 30, 7:30 p.m., in the Pine Room of the Glade Street YWCA. This is an important meeting, and you should plan to attend.
