WEST END STREET DANCE

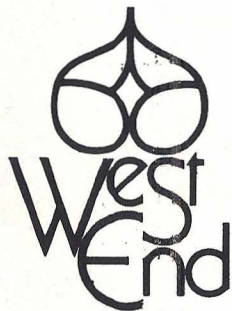

Grace Court Park is looking good, the fountains are in, the lamps are in operation, and grading has been done. Funds to complete everything but the brick wall on the northeast side are pledged.

The sidewalk art show, scheduled for this spring has been rescheduled for the spring of 1982! Grace Court Park is the place to have such an event and the park cannot be made ready for "company" this spring. Mary Beth Blackwell-Chapman had some more bad news - the music in the park programs which entertained so many families in Grace Court Park last summer has fallen to the government budget ax. No funds are available from the Urban Arts grant.
