

BOARD MEETING REPORT

The Board met on November 5th at the Wells-Sugg's home. The absence of Warren and Becky Sparrow was noted and excused. It was assumed that they were resting from the early a.m. victory in the District Attorney election. (Editorial Comment: Yeah! Warren! Congratulations.)

Chris Chapman passed on some good news from the local transit authority. By the end of 1987, new trolley-like buses will replace the large city buses on the West End Trolley route. These are being specially designed to mimic turn-of-the-century vehicles.

The Historic District Nomination has been blessed by Raleigh historians and sent on to Washington .

Chris and Lee Ann Pegram of the City-County Planning Board reported on a conference they attended recently on historic districts in early 20th Century neighborhoods. The West End can be a pacesetter in the State as this period is being recognized for its culture and historic significance.

Our next step is to begin drafting guidelines for a local appearance commission or local district. Glenn Gravlee heads this committee. They're discussing what the neighborhood should and should not have regulated. Call Chris at 723-7620 if you would like to join the committee.

More good news for the neighborhood - Brunson School is building a new playground. This will offer junior West Enders another place for recreation.


