## West End Association Annual Board Meeting

The annual Board meeting was held Tuesday, February 12, 1991 in the Pine Room at the YWCA. President, Bill Sugg called the meeting to order.

### Election of Officers/New Board Members

Glenn Simmons, chairperson of the Nominating Committee, presented the slate of officers and new Board members to be elected. Marty Lentz moved that she be elected as an alternate to the Board and that the nominees be approved by acclamation. Warren Sparrow seconded, the motion passed with no dissenting votes.

### Christmas House Tour

Lea Loftis reported that 1,090 people attended the tour in 1990. A total of \$7,955 was raised with a net of \$3,760. In 1988 the tour made \$1,804. Thanks and CONGRATULATIONS Susan Walter and Lea who chaired the Christmas Tour. There were numerous West Enders and others who helped with every detail to make this our best tour ever. Lea and Susan have written a report that the next chairpersons can use as a guide.

### Salvation Army Up-date

Bill Wise reported that the Salvation Army would be moving its headquarters from Marshall Street to the corner of Trade and Northwest Blvd. Getting to this decision, Bill noted, was tedious for the Salvation Army and the neighborhood on Marshall Street. Jeff Smith moved that the WEA send \$300.00 to the Salvation Army with a note for best wishes as a token of our support towards their new quarters. Randolph Horner seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

### Hanes Park

Lea Loftis gave an overview of the process the West End had gone through to get to the point now of having a proposed plan for improvements to the park. She noted the facilitative and consensus building role of our alderwoman, Nancy Pleasants during the meetings and discussions. Lea then introduced Joe Johnson, City landscape planner, who reviewed the active systems, minimal passive use, and maintenance needs of Hanes Park. He stated that money needed to improve the park would come from the City, private groups, and benefactors. The improvement plans include planting trees and flowers, building up the creek bank, and on-going maintenance by the City. 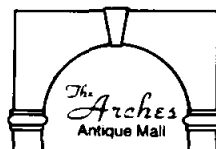

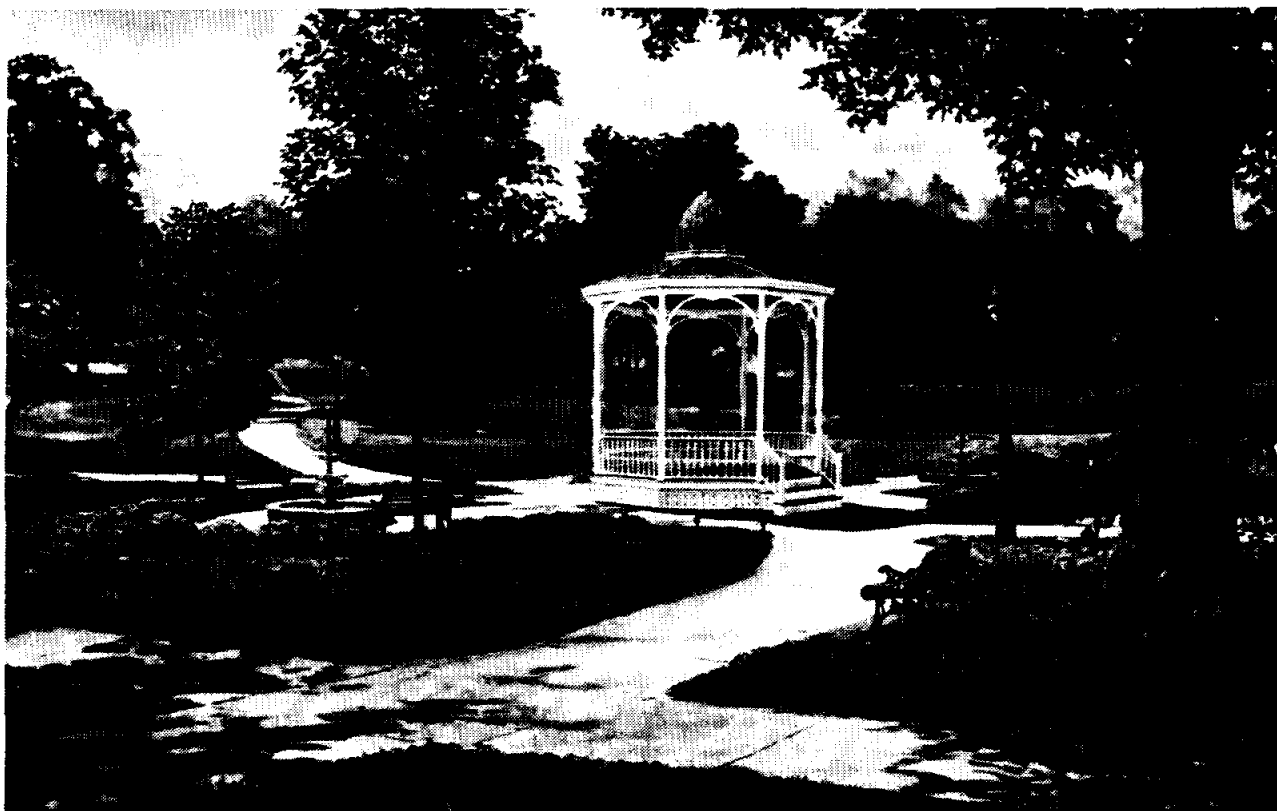
