OTHER EVENTS AT ANNUAL MEETING

Special Thanks

Outgoing president Wanda Merschel welcomed the group to the annual meeting. Attendance was great--almost 50 people braved the night to participate in the meeting. Secretary Cathy Long read the minutes of the previous meeting, which were approved. Wanda thanked previous president Bill Sugg for his leadership and assistance; Bill Wise for his efforts on zoning; Warren & Becky Sparrow for all their efforts in so many areas; Missie Vaughan for all her work on the historic district project, not to mention her additional contributions; Billye Keith Jones for the Holiday House Tour, the Festival at Grace Court, and everything else; and John Bills and Sami Ousley for their hard work on the social committee.

The slate of new officers and board members was approved by acclamation.

Our new president Jim Vaughan noted that he would like his first act as president to be a special "thank you" to outgoing president Wanda Merschel who does, has done, and will probably continue to do, so much for West End.

Slide Presentation

Dr. Douglas Young shared a slide presentation which featured the history of the Rotary Club in Winston-Salem. The Rotary was the first civic lunch club. Started by an attorney, the club had 24 members in 1915, many of whom resided in the West End, which was a highly desirable place to live (just as it is today). Dr. Young's presentation showed many homes in our neighborhood, as well as some in other neighborhoods.

Treasurer's Report

Outgoing treasurer David Wallace noted that the Association has \$3736.32 in the checking account; \$80.83 in the savings account; \$7468.04 in the National Historic Trust Fund; and \$2920.71 in the Barbara Smitherman Fund. Total funds on deposit are \$14205.90.
