Crichton-Atkinson House - ca. 1924

THE Bude Server

The Crichton-Atkinson House is an unusual bungalow with simple Classical detailing. It is a one-story stucco house with a hip roof, six-over-one sash windows, and a symmetrical façade. Whose central bay is emphasized by a pedimented entrance porch with slender Tuscan columns and a vaulted ceiling. James H. and Margaret



Crichton, both employees of R.J.Reynolds Tobacco Co., were the first to be listed at this location in the city directories (1925). In 1926 Mrs. Ada Atkinson, widow of J.B. Atkinson, purchased the property, but she was not listed here until the 1930 directory. The Atkinson family owned the house until 1972. Behind the house is a stucco garage with pyramidal roof which appears contemporary with the house. This is a beautiful house that the YMCA has purchased, let fall into disrepair, and plan to demolish along with the houses on either side to build a parking lot.

Comments on the subject: I thought the YMCA was supposed to help the community. Tearing down these houses will hurt the character of our historic district in a dramatic way. The YMCA needs to have a bit more vision, and try not to continually erode our neighborhood. I was told that the YMCA originally said their membership would not be over 1500, it has been as high as 8000. We already have to put up with excessive traffic and parking problems. Helping the parking problem is good, distorting the neighborhood to accomplish this is very bad. We have all made a major commitment and investment of time and money in this neighborhood; it is simply wrong for powerful organizations to push us around, diminishing our property values, by their continued negative impact on the historical character of our neighborhood. There is no good reason for the YMCA to demolish 3 contributing structures in our historic district to put in more hideous parking. Keep in mind this is how historic districts lose their historic status. We have seen one house torn down last year with another on 5th Street to follow soon. This slow destruction of homes could eventually jeopardize our historic status. Let the YMCA know what you think about their plans to demolish this and other homes in our neighborhood. Hawthorne Curve: Last month we had a letter from a reader regarding the construction on the Hawthorne Curve and the possible impact the higher elevation will have on the noise level in the neighborhood. We do not believe that the neighborhood association was contacted by the DOT prior to the construction. Lisa Elam contacted them last year about putting up sound barriers in the Sunset Street area. She was told that a sound barrier would send the noise to the neighborhood on the other side of the highway, but trees were a possibility. In any case, the DOT is using the area for equipment storage, and any improvements would have to wait until after construction is
