Historic Clock and Time Capsule Dedication

We have two time capsules, each is 12" by 12" by 24". Because space is limited, every group is guaranteed up to two 8 1/2" by 11" sheets to tell about themselves. Any contributions beyond that may or may not make it in due to space restrictions.

What can you put into the time capsule? Group pictures, a group autograph page, a history of your group or neighborhood, a neighborhood newsletter, a year 200 souvenir of a neighborhood event, art from children in your neighborhood, special stories about your place, things that you will remember about the year 2000.

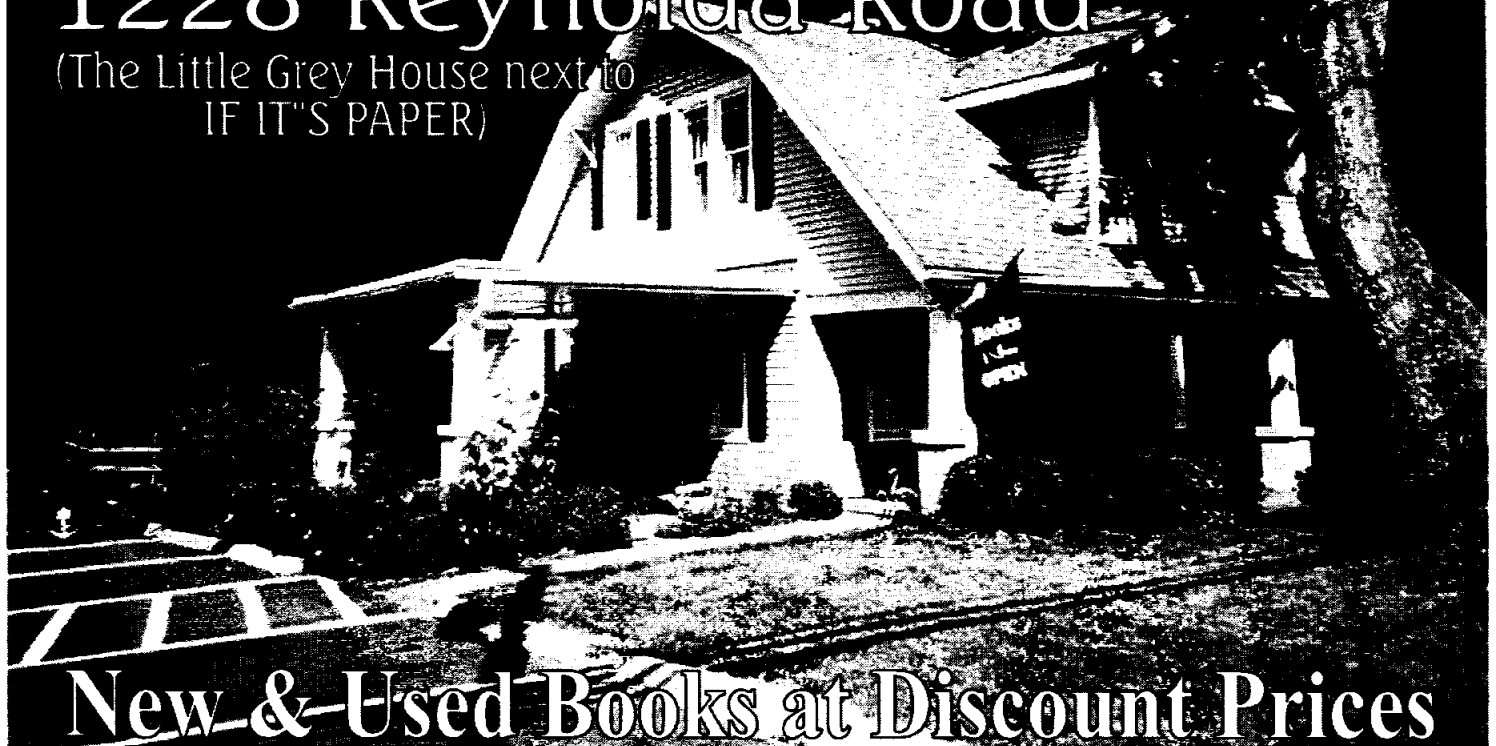
