**Notable Trees of the West End:
The Hemlock**



Hemlock: not what killed Socrates, but the large, evergreen tree with graceful swooping branches, small flat needles and a pyramidal shape that you can find throughout West End. This is a native tree found primarily in our mountains and north into Canada, hence its botanical name "tsuga canadenses." Although I have seen native stands as far east as Durham along the Eno river, I'm sure all of West End's hemlocks were planted.

A particularly nice specimen is found in a secret garden along the alleyway going from Summit back over to Manly Street. This hemlock stands to the left of a private drive as you go up the hill. It's probably about 50 years old and amazingly is not infested with the wooly adelgid, a sap sucking insect inadvertently brought over from Asia, which is decimating our hemlocks. A problem up north for decades, the adelgid has only in the last few years migrated to our neck of the woods. It appears as a white fuzzy substance where the needles meet the branches. Unfortunately there is little we can do short of spraying, which can be costly and dangerous. I recommend planting other species.

Portrait of a House



When Martha Harper put 909 West End Blvd on the house tour in the early 80's, a woman in her 70s arrived at the front door. "I was married in this house," she said, "and I thought you should have this photo." She handed Martha a picture of the house not long after it was built in 1912 by Ellen and Jonathan Gregg. Mr. Gregg was a traveling salesman. Mrs. Gregg, it should be noted, purchased the property in 1911. The woman with the photo was their daughter. The house remained in Gregg family ownership until 1955. Before Martha and Bill Harper bought the house in 1976 it was used as a boarding house for medical students and the front parlor was a bedroom. The Harpers raised three boys at 909 until the Thomas family arrived in April 2000. Stuart Thomas is with BB&T Insurance and Andrea is a journalist. Scout, 9, Emma, 7, and Bibi, 6 months, like to swing on the front porch.
