




Committee Reports

Historic Resources Committee-Jack Smith

Jack Smith reported that the City Council passed the Demolition by Neglect ordinance and Jack further discussed the procedure for nominating a property for consideration. The HRC requests that if an association identifies a property to be considered, the association must first approach the property owner and try to resolve the issues. If the two parties can not make progress on the concerns, then the HRC can be asked to intervene.

Beautification Committee- Jack Smith

The West End Garden Club planted 2500 bulbs in Grace Court on Saturday, December 3. This is the second winter in which the garden club has planted bulbs in Grace Court. Keep your eye out for the spectacular spring color show in the court in May '06.

Safety ad hoc-Captain Belton and Lieutenant Cobb

Over the past two months the city has experienced increase in house break-ins. West End experienced fourteen during the month of November. Most of the crime occurred in two areas of West End, near Summit and Broad Street and over in the vicinity of Business 40. Captain Belton stated that the best way to stop crime is to call 911 if they see any suspicious activity and keep neighbors informed of crime that occurs on their street. Lt. Cobb stated that the police have deployed extra plain-clothes police officers to patrol specific areas that are experiencing the increased crime activity.
