PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

'Tis the Season to be Wary!
The weekend after Thanksgiving, I was returning from vacation in Mexico. While going through customs (enjoying the wonders of international travel-NOT!), my wife Nora picked up a message on her cell phone from our alarm company. Our alarm system had been triggered that very day - in fact just a few hours before! Imagine our anguish - we're in Atlanta creeping through a passport line and won't be home until midnight! Not much we can do but call and see what we can find out. Reaching ADT customer service, we received the news that the alarm went off around 2:00 Saturday afternoon...and that the alert was issued to the Winston Salem police...who arrived three minutes later! (Yes, you read that right! - a big Thank You to our law enforcement folks!) The police could find no signs of forced entry so apparently it was a false alarm triggered by who knows what. Lots of things ran through our minds - had we stopped the newspapers? the mail? left lights on with random on and off times, along with a radio? Did we tell the neighbors we were out of town? Had we left contact information with some friends? As we ruminated over these and other precautions, it struck me that maybe these kinds of things should be implemented even when we're out for the night - not just away for a week at a time. Burglars really don't want to encounter homeowners - they just want what you own, preferably small expensive stuff they can pawn quickly to feed whatever habit they have. Let's not make it easy for them. Recently there has been a rash of vehicle break-ins that suggest the West End has once again been targeted by some marauding miscreants. With the holidays upon us, the police say that this "shopping" activity is likely to increase as local and visiting B&E specialists (that's breaking and entering, folks) start working through their own Christmas shopping lists. Let's be mindful of our neighbors' activities and routines, suspicious when the situation calls for it, and alert to things that go bump in the night - that sound you hear just may be not be St. Nick coming to make an early call but someone stuffing a bag with *your* goodies. To recall an old 80's cop show signature line: "Let's be careful out there". And have a happy, joyful, and safe holiday season.
