As we say goodbye to 2007 and welcome 2008, I can't help thinking about the original West Enders and how they may have celebrated the coming of the New Year, 1908.

Did anyone travel to New York City to see the inaugural ball drop in New York City's Times Square? Did they stay closer to home and attend grand parties hosted by the Hanes and Reynolds families? Did they take one of the nation's first electric street cars to visit family and friends in town? Did they buy provisions for their New Year's meal at Joyner's West End Grocery at the corner of Burke and Fourth streets? Did they toast one another with a "Fine Carbonic Drink," Bennett's Cola?

In the early 20th century, the West End neighborhood became not only a neighborhood of winding streets and beautiful homes, but also housed many of the influential residents of the day. Today, the historic homes remain and the residents are just as influential to the neighborhood and city.


Learning from History
As so many of us were disappointed that we could not light our luminaries on Christmas Eve due to the statewide burn ban, we must remember all of the West End structures that we lost to fire, such as the Davis School military academy and Hotel Zinzendorf. We can be thankful that local fire officials care about us.

We will hope for an end to drought conditions and we will illuminate the West End for the Holiday Home Tour and on Christmas Eve in 2008.

I just wanted to remind you all that these upcoming and new board members are your neighbors who are building their futures here in the West End, raising families and raising awareness of issues near and dear to all of us who abide here. Give them a hand if you can, it's your neighborhood too. That starts by coming to the February WEA Annual meeting to vote them into office. I'll be there to hand over my gavel.
