A Letter from the President...

Dear West End neighbors,

Somebody made the comment to me the other day that [volunteering] can be a thankless job— and you're not getting paid— so why would you do it? I looked at them and to my astonishment, the only answer that came to mind was the simple fact that I enjoy it. 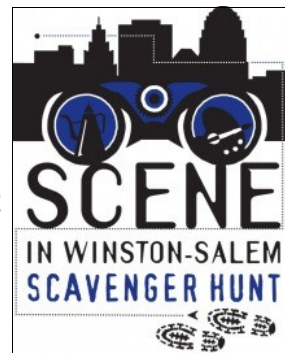
Scene in Winston-Salem Scavenger Hunt is April 24th
