## **West End Babysitting Co-Operative**

Once upon a time (circa 1980) in the leafy, magical community of West End, there lived about 20 families who had young children. But they were sad because they couldn't find dependable babysitters and they didn't know each other very well. And, lo, there appeared a fairy godmother, from the faraway city of Charlotte, who bestowed on them the gift of a babysitting co-op and they lived happily ever after, or most of them did.

Ok, so we fast forward to 2010 and, once again, the still leafy, still magical West End has many parents who would love to recreate the co-op idea. Here are some basic suggestions gleaned from the memories of the (aging and therefore somewhat undependable) original group:

- A point system was used, and the points were owed to the co-op not an individual
- If you had one child and you took the child to the a co-op member's house, it was 2 points an hour; if you had 2 children it was 3 points an hour; 3 children 4 points, etc.
- If you had one child and a member came to your house, it was 3 points an hour; if you had 2 children it was 4 points an hour, etc.
- There was a book-system used then but now it could be done online. This duty was shared by members on a rotating basis as a way to keep up with points
- The system used the honor system, with the person doing the sitting calling the points in to the person responsible for the "book". It should be much easier with an online system.

The secret of the success of the West End Babysitting Coop was the social part of it. Once a month the families would gather for a potluck with the children. It was either at a member's house or, in good weather, at Hanes Park. We used that occasion to read out the points so folks could keep up with their status. That is, whether they owed points or whether they were owed points. Parents and children got to know each other really well and that was one of the primary joys of the co-op.

We each had a list of the other members with telephone numbers and addresses to call around to find someone who was available to sit at a particular time. (It seems difficult to believe that folks didn't have e-mail addresses then but we were in the dark ages.) There were additional embellishments such as "superpoints" which were used for weekends but no one seems to remember the details. We, the aging, will leave it to you voungsters to work that one out.

Now, a closing word from Wendy, the West End Windbag, whose legendary column in the West Ender in the eighties made her a household word and almost won her a Pulitzer or was it a howitzer.....

"Well, I was sort of everybody's Official Grandma back in those days, and it pleased me to no end to see all those young people in the midst of their reproductive years helping to actively raise each others' chirren. Those kids turned out pretty well, and all the parents can take credit for it . . . except for those folks that up and moved away leaving 77 points in the hole. Anyhow, as I used to tell 'em over a big chunk of Boston Cream Pie at the potlucks, this here is a dang good way to ward off existential angst."
