**HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS**

Halloween is an exciting time of year for kids, and to help ensure they have a safe holiday, here are some tips from the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).

**ALL DRESSED UP:**  
Plan costumes that are bright and reflective. Make sure that shoes fit well and that costumes are short enough to prevent tripping, entanglement or contact with flame. Consider adding reflective tape or striping to costumes and Trick-or-Treat bags for greater visibility. Because masks can limit or block eyesight, consider non-toxic makeup and decorative hats as safer alternatives. When shopping for costumes, wigs and accessories look for and those with a label clearly indicating they are flame resistant.

**CARVING A NICHE:**  
Small children should never carve pumpkins! Children can draw a face with markers. Then parents can do the cutting. Votive candles are safest for candle-lit pumpkins.

**HOME SAFE HOME:**  
To keep homes safe for trick-or-treaters, parents should remove from the porch and front yard anything a child could trip over such as garden hoses, toys, bikes and lawn decorations. Parents should check outdoor lights and replace burned-out bulbs. Restrain pets so they do not inadvertently jump on or bite a trick-or-treater.

**ON THE TRICK-OR-TREAT TRAIL:**  
A parent or responsible adult should always accompany young children on their neighborhood rounds. If your older children are going alone, plan and review the route that is acceptable to you. Agree on a specific time when they should return home. Only go to homes with a porch light on and never enter a home or car for a treat. Because pedestrian injuries are the most common injuries to children on Halloween, remind Trick-or-Treaters of the following:

- Stay in a group and communicate where they will be going.
- Carry a cell phone for quick communication.
- Remain on well-lit streets and always use the sidewalk.
- Never cut across yards or use alleys.
- Only cross the street as a group in established crosswalks). Never cross between parked cars or out driveways.
- Law enforcement authorities should be notified immediately of any suspicious or unlawful activity.

**HEALTHY HALLOWEEN:**  
A good meal prior to parties and trick-or-treating will discourage youngsters from filling up on Halloween treats. Wait until children are home to sort and check treats. Though tampering is rare, a responsible adult should closely examine all treats and throw away any spoiled, unwrapped or suspicious items. Try to ration treats for the days following Halloween.
