Historic Homes Open for Tour 4 December 2022



Ine historic homes, recently restored St. Paul's Episcopal Church, and Joyner's Grocery, the oldest commerical building in the dirstrict will be open for tours during the West End Holiday Homes Tour. Advance ticket sales are available online at our tour web page (historicwestend.org/2022-homes-tour) soon. Tickets will be available on the day of the tour at Joymongers Barrel Hall, across from the northern end of Hanes Park at 480 West End Blvd.

Several of the houses are clustered together near St. Paul's Church on Summit Street but others can be reached by walking several blocks. The West End neighborhood has some significant hills so shuttles will be available to take guests who need transportation to any of the

Ludlow and Sheppard Houses Restored!

The West Ender has followed the saga of the restoration of the Jacob Lott Ludlow and B.J. Sheppard Houses for years. The "Before" and "After" photos below show the transformation that Alspaugh and Baldwin have made since acquiring the properties. Restorations were not yet complete in September when we visited the houses (note the construction supplies on the porch). The changes in the houses have been dramatic. The Baldwin team plans to have both houses ready for occupancy in December. They will be operated as a Bed and Breakfast Inn. Ludlow has 4 rooms and Sheppard has 6. Tour guests will visit both houses to see the restorations for themselves. Plan to attend the 2022 West End Holiday Homes Tour.
